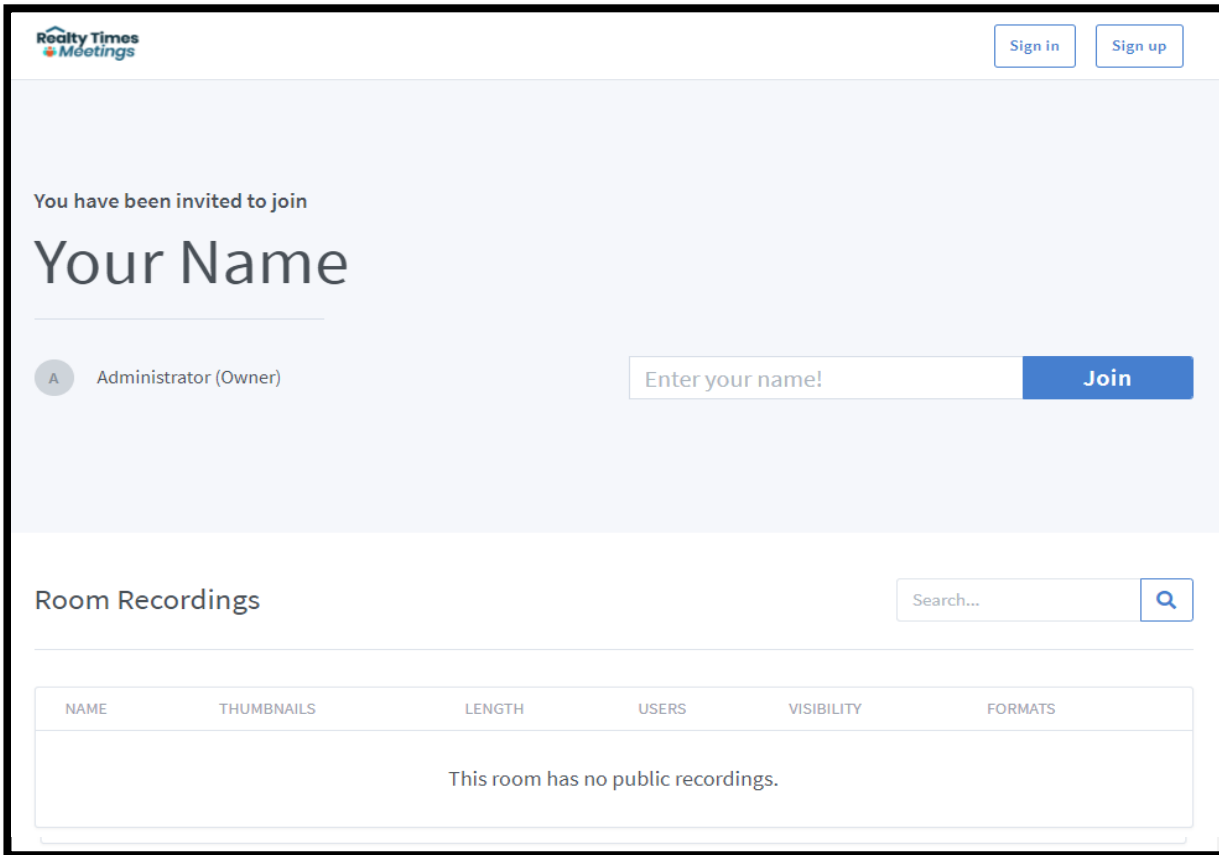

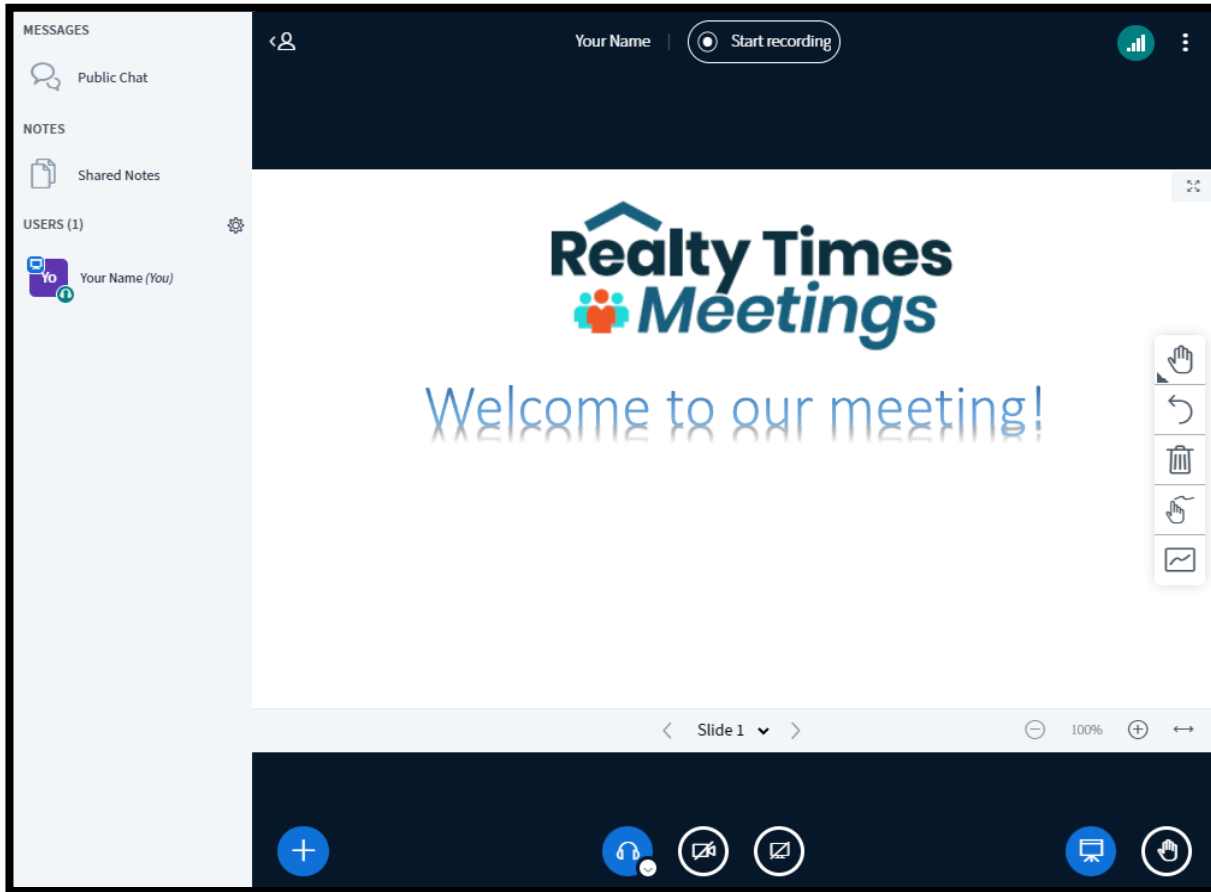
- You next screen will ask if you would like to join using your microphone or listen only.

- An echo test may be performed, select YES

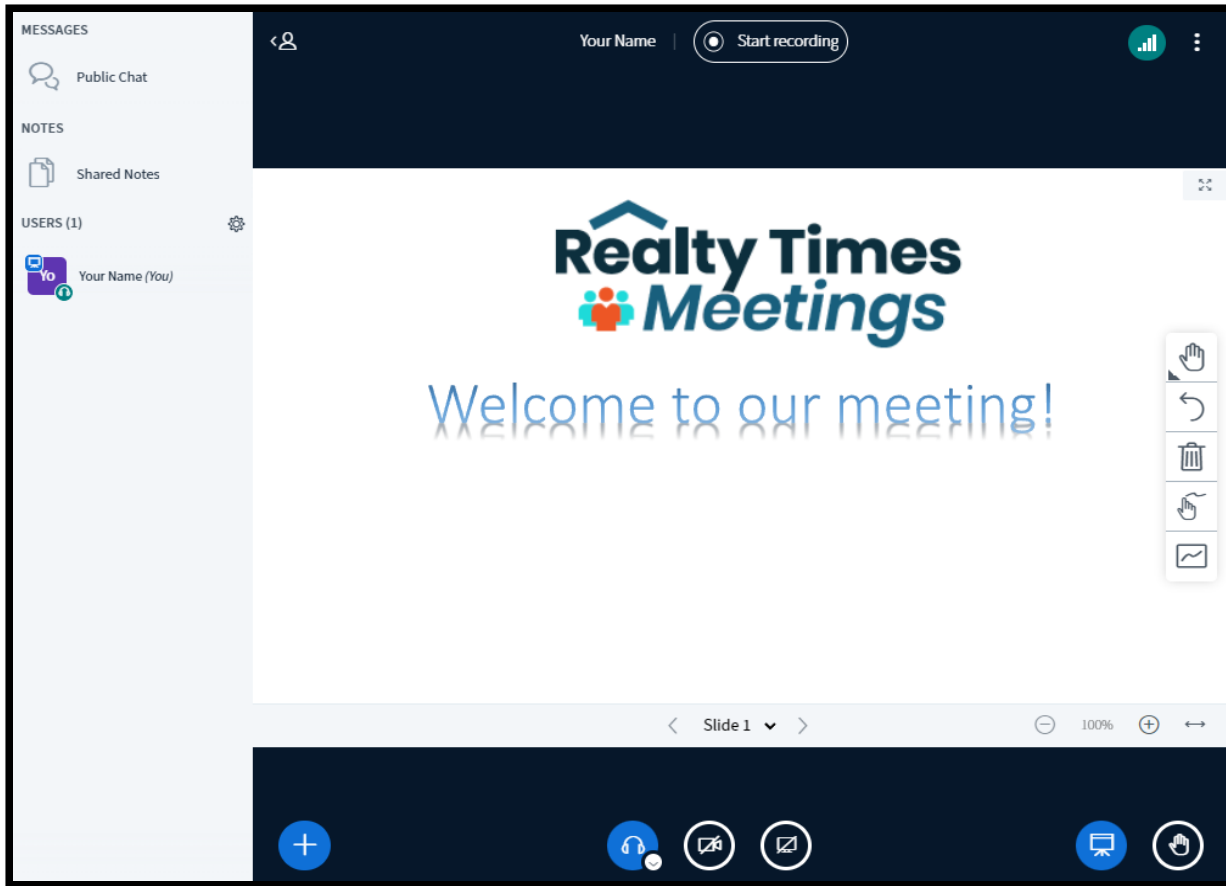

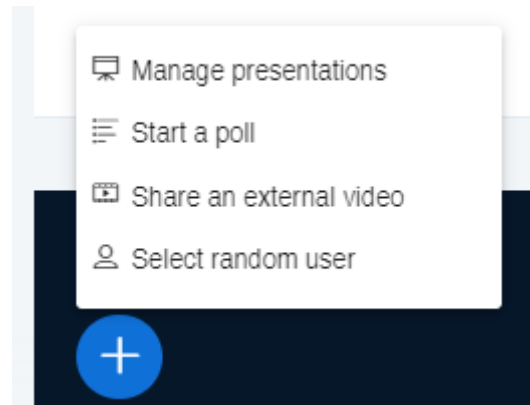
- Mute, video, and share functions are at the bottom center of the screen.
- All users on the call are listed on the left side of the screen.
- Users are not required to register.
- Users may manage their webcam, audio, or share their screen (to assign screen share status, click on username).
- A user may take the presentation by selecting the blue + icon 



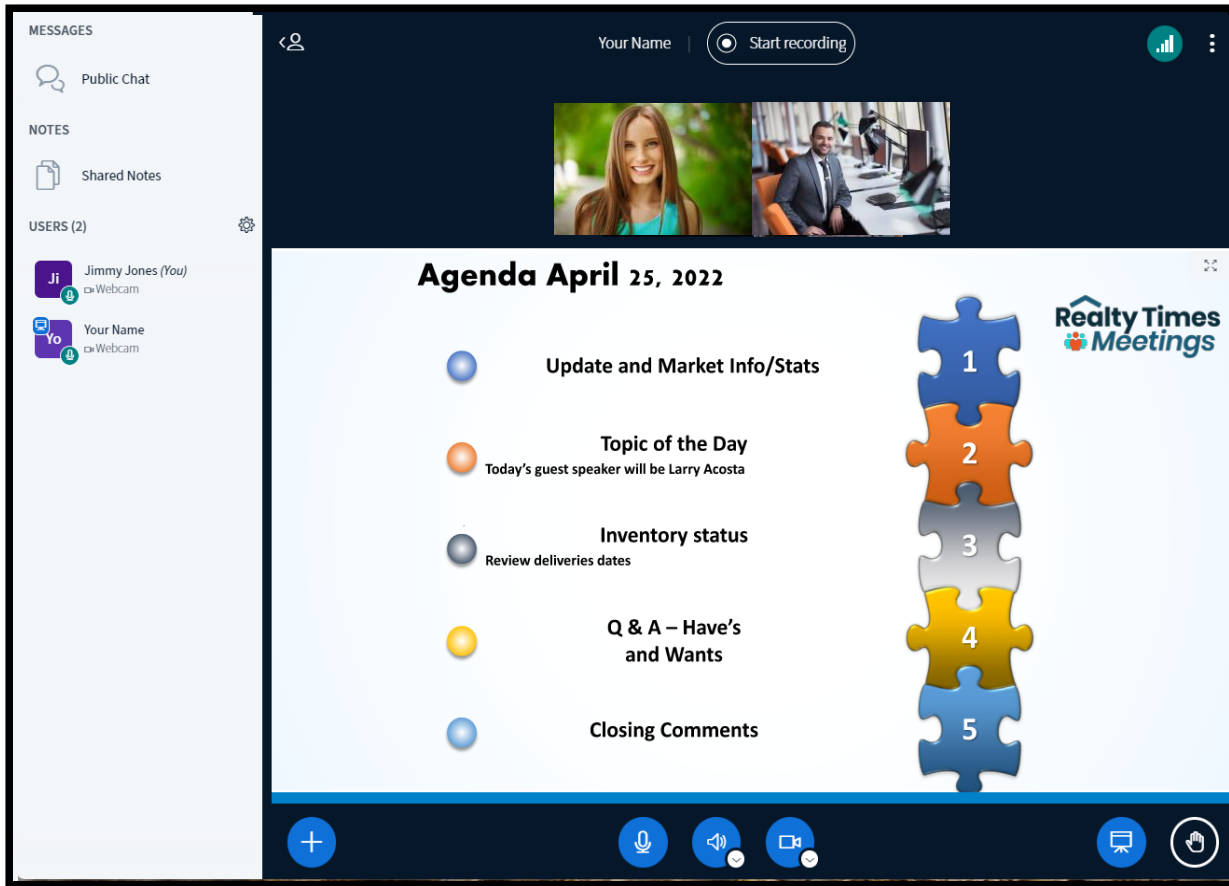
Initiate Conference Call



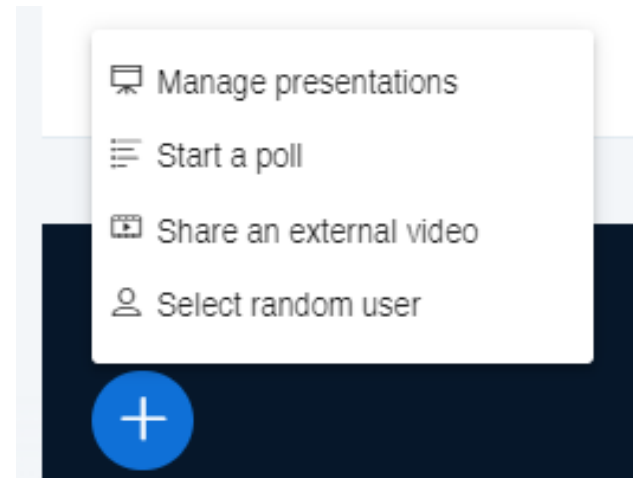
- The “screen” icon  located on the bottom right allows for a presentation or whiteboard to be displayed. This allows a user to display an image, video, or presentation. Users may interact on this screen.
- Presenting user may load a presentation or a video link by selecting the blue + icon. 



Start a Presentation

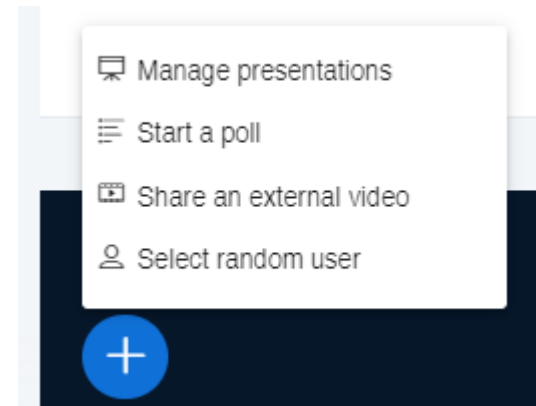


- Here's an example of adding and displaying a PDF (saved from PowerPoint). Multiple pages may be used.

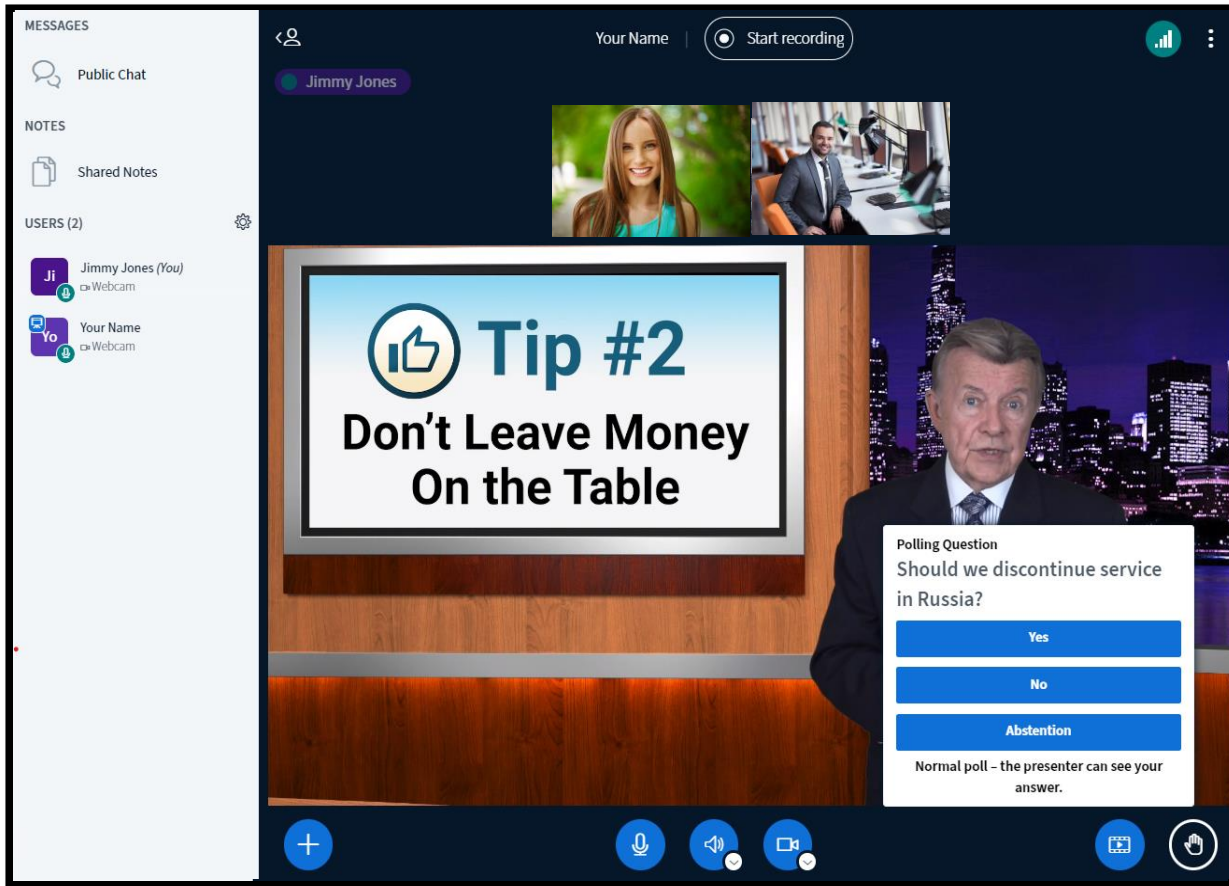


Present Videos

Note: Vote/poll may only be initiated by presenter 

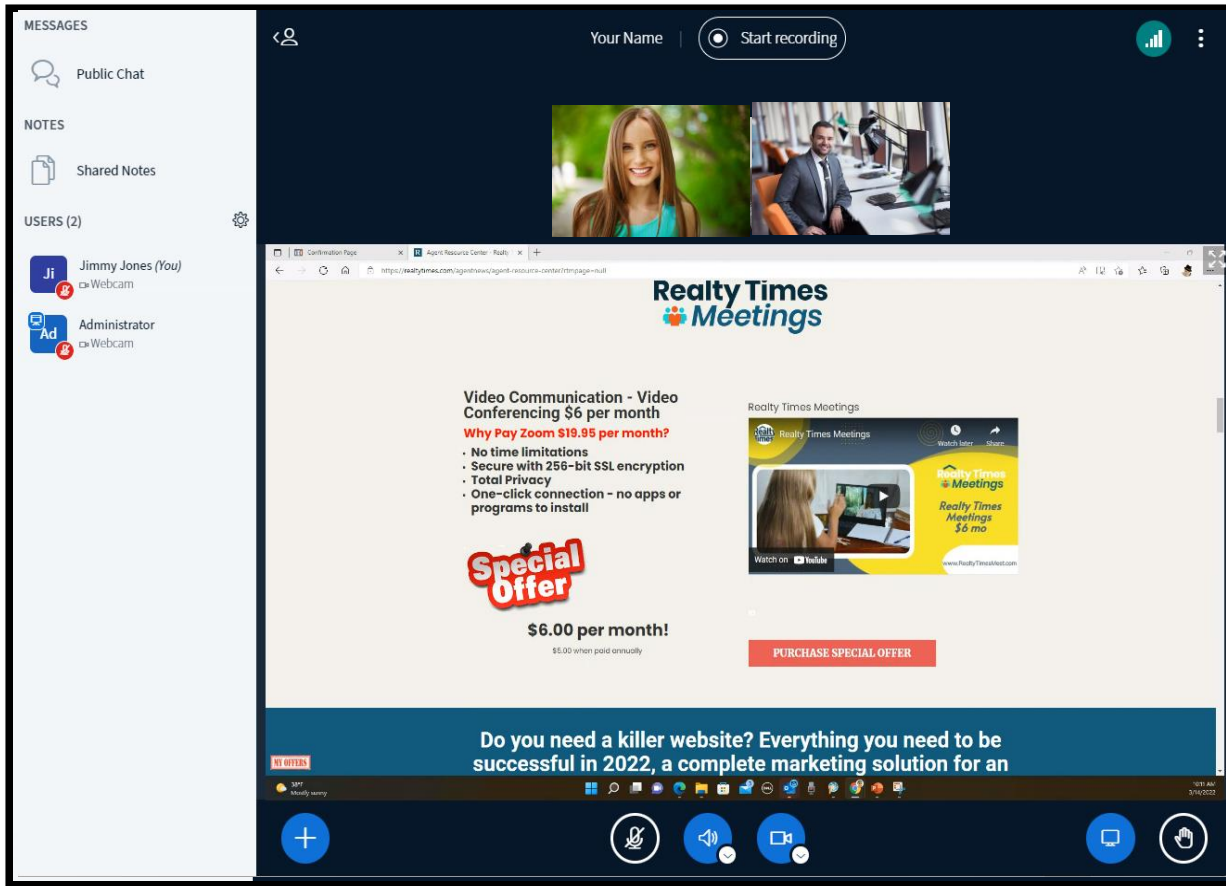

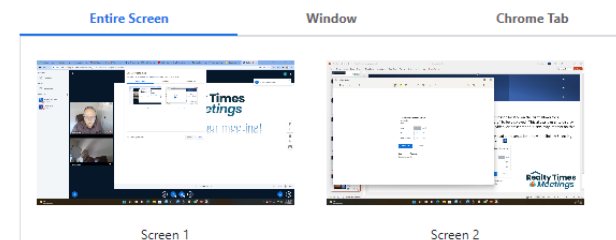
○ Here's an example of screen sharing.

Realty Times Meetings (RTM) runs within your mobile browser. RTM runs on **iOS version 12.2+ and Android version 6.0+**. To join a session, you click a link within the browser or a mobile app (such as Moodle Mobile), and RTM will run within Safari Mobile (iOS) or Google Chrome (Android).

Desktop support
